Tuberculosis The Main Problem, Being Malnourished Its Consequence

40 % of Cambodian children younger than 5 years should be malnourished. That is told by International Organizations. It is echoed by International medias on the occasion of the Cambodian elections.

We think there is a lack of understanding and a political global lack of willingness to know the reason why most of these children among these 40% are malnourished and too thin. It is due to diseases, especially due to Tuberculosis, being still the main problem of Health for Cambodian children.


If the International Organizations, especially WHO and Unicef, would have done a CT Scanner of these 40% of children, they would have found in 90% the evidence, that they are infected by Tuberculosis.

The Primary Complex of Tuberculosis (most can only be detected by the CT Scanner) in the infected child is absorbing parts of the immunity potential in order to contain the Primary Complex and to prevent the TB germ from being spread out and being disseminated in the whole body of the child and causing the TB disease, for example TB Meningitis, TB Encephalitis, TB Cerebritis and Miliary Tuberculosis (see MRI pictures of one patient hospitalized at times in Kantha Bopha with the deadly disease Tuberculosis). So the TB infected, not only the TB sick child, is more vulnerable to other germs and diseases.

But even if the Primary Complex is well contained, some TB germs are being spread out minutes by minutes in the body consuming Vitamin B for example. That is why not only the child being sick by Tuberculosis but only infected by Tuberculosis too, is malnourished and thin!

WHO and Unicef are still doing and propagating the vaccine BCG against TB. This vaccine is not effective...but to them still good enough for the poor people in poor countries. No one child is vaccinated in US or Europe. By our experience over 21 years time in Cambodia we are convinced, that children being vaccinated by BCG are suffering from a more severe Tuberculosis than children being not vaccinated.
