



The Kantha Bopha Children's Hospitals of Cambodia on June 9, 2011

On June 9, on a day as any other day around here, and without any declared epidemic, the hospital activity at Kantha Bopha has been enormous, nevertheless, even over night. **1943 severely sick children were hospitalized.**

Activity in Phnom Penh:

Sick children treated at the out patient facilities:	2120
Hospital admissions of severely sick children:	263 (47 over night)
Surgical procedures:	32 (4 over night)
Discharge of hospitalized children:	184

Activity in Siem Reap Angkor:

Sick children treated at the out patient facilities:	1025
Hospital admissions of severely sick children:	182 (34 over night)
Surgical procedures:	26 (1 over night)
Deliveries at the maternity clinic:	52 (32 over night)
Discharge of hospitalized children:	168

On Tuesday, June 7 a severe sick child was diagnosed as **bird flu**. It is the fifth case in 2011. Kantha Bopha is the only place, where the diagnosis is done. All the time the government is immediately informed.

A total of 74 severely sick children required immediate admission to the intensive care units. They would not have survived, not even during the 24 hours while the admissions took place. All this occurred on June 9, on a day like any other day.

80% of all hospitalized children have no chance at least within the 4 months following the hospitalization.

All treatment is free for all patients. 90% of the patients families have a daily income of 0,5 USD. It is a huge misery.
